- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor and not previously shown at the Teulon Ag Fair.
- In the absence of competition in any section, or if the submission is of inferior quality, the judges will award only such prizes as they think deserving. The judge's decisions are final.
- No exhibitor is permitted to enter more than one article in any class subsection.
- Entries will be accepted at the Teulon Hall Friday evening between 7 and 8 pm and Saturday morning from 8:30 am – 9:30 am.
- There is one Best In Show chosen in each class, with the exception of Class 1.
- Judging takes place from 10 am – 12 pm.
- All entries will remain in the Hall until 4 pm.
- Prize money will be available at 12:30 pm.

CLASS 1 - Largest Pumpkin

Must be grown by exhibitor.

Please bring on a pallet. Entries received Saturday only.

1st - \$1,000 2nd - \$500 3rd - \$300

CLASS 2 - Pumpkins and Gourds

Subcategories 1-3 must be grown by exhibitor

12 & under 13 & over

1. Most perfect pumpkin – up to 22" circumference
2. Most perfect pumpkin – over 22" circumference
3. Most unusual pumpkin or gourd – any size
4. Best carved pumpkin
5. Best decorated pumpkin



CLASS 3 - Fruits and Vegetables

All ages. Must be grown by exhibitor.

1. Collection of fruits and vegetables - at least five kinds, artistically arranged
2. Three carrots - with 1/4" top arranged on a plate
3. Three beets - with 1/4" top arranged on a plate
4. Three potatoes - arranged on a plate
5. Three onions - outer skin on, arranged on a plate
6. Collection of five tomatoes - arranged on a plate
7. Three apples - any variety, arranged on a plate
8. Most unusual vegetable
9. Heaviest vine vegetable (other than pumpkin)
10. Heaviest root vegetable



CLASS 4 - Baking

Open to all ages.

1. Pumpkin pie
2. Other pie
3. Dessert loaf - any kind, pumpkin, lemon etc.
4. Loaf of bread - any kind, sourdough, white etc.
5. Cookies - four arranged on a plate
6. Cupcakes, iced - four arranged on a plate
7. Cake - minimum two tiers, on a plate
8. Square/dainty - any kind, four arranged on a plate



CLASS 5 - Canning

Open to all ages

1. One jar jam or jelly - any kind
2. One jar relish
3. One jar salsa
4. One jar dill pickles
5. One jar pickled beets
6. One jar other pickled vegetable



CLASS 6 - Handicrafts

Ages 12 & up

1. Needlework - one embroidery/cross stitch piece
2. Knitted or Crocheted - one article
3. Quilting - one article
4. Jewelry or beadwork creation
5. Handmade greeting card
6. Photograph - landscape - unframed, no filter
7. Photograph - any subject matter - animals, people, flowers etc. - unframed, no filter
8. Painting - water colour, oil or acrylic - landscape
9. Painting - water colour, oil or acrylic - any other subject matter
10. Drawing - unframed, colour or black and grey, any subject matter
11. Handmade family heirloom - quilted, knitted etc.
12. Woodworking - subject matter open



CLASS 7 - Floral Arrangements

Open to all ages

1. Fall table centerpiece - real flowers, view from one side
2. Bouquet of assorted flowers - presented in a vase, view from one side, any flower variety
3. Bouquet of marigolds - presentation open
4. Bouquet of zinnias - presentation open



CLASS 8 - Junior Artwork

Preschool Ages 5-7 Ages 8-11

1. Fall inspired craft - drawing, painting etc.
2. Favourite piece of art from 2025/2026 - collage, original poetry, clay work, LEGO creation etc.
3. Handmade greeting card
4. Jewelry or beadwork creation
